Consent Form

Great Falls Walleyes Unlimited will be hosting a Kids' Fishing Camp on August 14,15,16 at Tiber Reservoir. We will be accepting 50 applicants from boys or girls from ages 11-15. Included in the 3 days, 2-night Camp is safety courses, on and off water activities, and a Fish, Wildlife and Parks sponsored safety course. Seminars on fishing techniques, technologies, strategies, uses of current fishing technologies, and spinner making is planned. We plan on having 2 to 3 children per boat for on the water instruction. Life jackets will be provided and are mandatory anytime kids are on the water. (If children have their own life Jacket they are encouraged to bring them)

This will be an Adult Supervised Camp.

Meals and tents will be provided. *Girls are encouraged to attend and will be housed in an all-female tent with female chaperones*

Each student will be responsible for his or her own personal equipment, such as sleeping bags, personal items, and appropriate clothing for the weather. (THIS IS A NO electronic camp, cell phones not advised because there isn't cellular service at Tiber Reservoir)

ALL PARTICIPANTS should bring for personal use **Life Jacket / Life Preserver**

Students will be responsible for their own transportation to and from North Middle School. Drop off for your child is Friday, August 14, between 2:00 and 2:30 PM and pick up is Sunday, August 16, between 5:00 and 5:30 PM at North Middle School. A bus will transport students from North Middle School to Tiber Reservoir and back.

Personal References are required to participate. Please be advised that this is a camp for kids who have experience and really like camping and fishing. ALL participants MUST USE GOOD MANNERS & BE WELL BEHAVED, OR THEY WILL BE IMMEDIATELY SENT HOME.

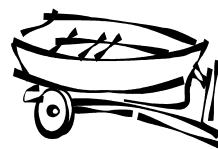

Camp Walleye is an opportunity for young adults to experience fishing with veteran fishing captains, learn fishing etiquette, boat safety, fish identification, and camping.

This opportunity comes with responsibility. For the safety and enjoyment of everyone in attendance at Camp Walleye, the following are the Rules and Expectations for Camp Walleye. All campers will be expected to follow all the rules.

Campers who break the rules will immediately be expelled from Camp Walleye, and parents or guardians will be responsible and make themselves available by phone if called to drive to Camp to pick up the expelled camper. If parent or guardian doesn't come and immediately pick their child up, the child will be delivered to their home at parent or guardians expense.

Please read the following Rules and Expectations and initial stating you have read and understood the Rules and Expectations and the consequences should infractions occur.

Camper Initials	Rule or Expectation	Parent Initials
	Camper(s) will at no time have weapons of any kind at Camp, <u>including, but not limited to, firearms and knives.</u> Additional definitions of weapons will be determined by Camp Advisors. If weapons are brought to Camp Walleye, camper(s) will be immediately expelled.	
	Camper(s) will at no time have <u>alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs</u> on Campgrounds. Any prescription drugs that campers need to take should be identified, and Camp Advisors should be notified. If alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs are found at Camp, the camper(s) will be immediately expelled.	
	Camper(s) will refrain from using profanity during Camp Walleye if camper(s) use profanity while at Camp Walleye – they will be immediately expelled.	
	<u>Fighting, hazing, harassment, intimidation, bullying</u> of other campers or camp staff is strictly prohibited at Camp and will not be tolerated. Should Camp Advisors determine that camper(s) is engaging in fighting, hazing, harassment, intimidation, or bullying, camper(s) will be immediately expelled.	
	For safety purposes, camper(s) will be expected to listen to Camp Advisors and Boat Captains at all times. Should Camp Advisors feel that camper(s) are not in accordance with this expectation and that the safety of Boat Captains or other campers is at risk, camper(s) will be immediately expelled.	
	Cell phones and other recording devices should be used with the approval of	

	Camp Advisors. Misuse will be grounds for the immediate expulsion of the camper(s).	
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
